

**Pleasantville Community School
Regular Meeting of the Board of Education
High School Media Center
Monday, November 11, 2013
6:30 p.m.**

The Pleasantville School Board met in regular session on November 11, 2013 at 6:30 P.M. in the High School Media Center. Present: Padellford, Ray, Dejoode, Sutter and Danks.

6:30 p.m. Padellford called the meeting to order.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said by all present.

Motion made by Ray and seconded by DeJoode to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried (5-0).

Motion made by Sutter and seconded by DeJoode to approve the minutes, bills and financials. Motion carried (5-0).

Mrs. Schloemer, Kaitlyn Sandholdt, and Kylie VanHaalen reported to the Board on the 8th grade trip to Washington D.C.

Principal Harrison commented that parent/teacher conferences went well. She is working on a second book for staff development. She invited the Board to spend a morning at the elementary to see how well the staff is working.

Principal Friday described the IPI assessments for teachers. He also handed out planning sheets for the J-Term classes starting in January.

Principal Cook commented on the quality of the Veteran's Day assembly and mentioned the improvement in our fall athletics over last year. He also mentioned the school play went really well.

Motion made by DeJoode and seconded by Sutter to approve Joel Allman-JH Girls Basketball at \$1,939.00 and Brittane Grove-Asst. HS Softball at \$2,631.50. Motion carried (5-0).

Motion made by Ray and seconded by DeJoode to approve the resignation of Bob Miller as Superintendent. Motion carried (5-0).

Facility rental agreements were discussed and a proposal will be brought at a future meeting.

Board policy 403.10 and 403.11 were discussed. Motion made by Ray and seconded by DeJoode to approve. Motion carried (5-0).

Motion made by Sutter and seconded by Danks to approve the application for Modified Allowable Growth for the SBRC. Motion carried (5-0).

Motion made by Sutter and seconded by Ray to approve a resolution for participation in the Hazard Mitigation Plan. Roll call vote: Padellford-aye, Danks-aye, Ray-aye, Dejoode-aye, Sutter-aye. Motion carried (5-0).

The Board discussed whether to use a search firm in the process of hiring a new Superintendent.

Curt Wolfe addressed the Board concerning reading concerns with his children. He was also inquiring into the MS math program. No action was taken by the Board.

Motion made by Ray and seconded by Sutter to adjourn. Motion carried (5-0).
