IPI was a centerpiece professional development initiative for the district seven years ago to develop skills at increasing student and staff engagement. Engagement is heavily linked to increased performance on high-stakes tests and overall satisfaction.

LEVELS:

- 1 no engagement or non-curricular work
- 2 students engaged, teacher not
- 3 students doing lower-level cognitive work (practice), teacher engaged
- 4 teacher-led instruction
- 5 higher-level cognitive work, peer-to-peer discussions, teacher engaged
- 6 higher-level cognitive work, individual only, teacher engaged


FAST Testing: A reading screener used at the elementary to identify the overall health of a school's reading program as well as find students needing interventions and support. 80% is the desired goal for a building.

Iowa Assessments Proficiency: Examine to see how many students are reaching benchmarks for proficiency in reading, math & science. 80% is the desired goal for a building (per AYP).

Iowa Assessments Growth: Examines student performance over two consecutive years compared to expected gain scores. Positive growth at each grade level is the desired goal.


ACT: Used to examine if our students are prepared for college-level coursework compared to state averages. At or above the state average is the desired goal.

FAST - Elementary




Iowa Assessments - Proficiency in Math




Iowa Assessments - Proficiency in Reading




Iowa Assessments - Proficiency in Science
