- Volunteering with community service organizations
- Helping to improve school buildings & grounds
- Helping at donation centers
- Volunteering for a political party or campaign
- Assisting teachers during school day
- NHS Blood drive (donating and/or working)
- Assisting at a hospital, shelter, nursing home, food pantry
- Volunteering for school sponsored events you are not a participant in
- Youth athletics – coaching, refereeing, scoreboard, clinics, concession stands
- Providing assistance to elderly neighbors or those with financial difficulties (yard work, repairs, upkeep, laundry)
- Volunteering for special church projects, mission trips
- Tutoring students before or after school (unpaid)
- Volunteering as a counselor
- Volunteering at an animal shelter / humane society
- Cleaning up highways, school grounds, community
- Helping teachers during non-school hours
- Providing service in association with Scouts or 4H

**Service opportunities may not include:**

- Any task where money is received
- Babysitting
- Court-ordered community service
- School extra-curricular activities of which you are a team member
- Any service provided for a business, whether it is paid or unpaid, cannot be used unless the business itself is doing a Charity/Community event
- Family chores, family child care
- Attending church or Sunday School
- Working for a relative
- Activities that are part of a class assignment
